On 2 June in Tokyo, the Graduate School of System Informatics and **Education Center on Computational** Science of Kobe University concluded an inter-faculty Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences of the University of Oslo. A signing ceremony was held at Tokyo Plaza Heisei, where the Japan-Norway Arctic Science and Innovation Week (ASIW) 2016 had been taking place. The signing was executed by Professor TAMAKI Hisashi (Dean of the Graduate School of System Informatics) and Professor Svein Stølen (Vice Dean of the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences). In the presence of Mr. Erling Rimestad (Ambassador of Norway to Japan) and

other distinguished guests, Professor YUI Kiyomitsu (Executive Assistant to the President in Charge of International Collaboration, Kobe University) and Dr. Bjørn Haugstad (Deputy Minister, The Norwegian Ministry of Education and Research) gave encouraging speeches on the two universities' joint research on the numerical simulation of rocket-plasma interactions.
