- Gender mainstreaming within all five sectors
- Gender-specific programming



Challenges for Sustainable and Gender Equal Societies

- Continuing gender gaps in education
- •Unequal access to resources for women and men
- Women excluded from leadership and decision making positions
 Continuing issues of violence and insecurity affecting women



Priorities for sustainable development and gender equality

- Improve identification of barriers and developing opportunities for women in science, technology and engineering
- Foster mentoring
- Promote the transformation of institutions, both public and private, to support women in science at every level



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UNESCO Activities for Women's Empowerment and Gender Equality

- Girls' and women's Education (including science education)
- Promoting women's leadership
- Capacity building for research and training
 - Research and Documentation Centres
 - Global Chairs Network
- Prevention of violence and promotion of women's security
