- (1) What I saw was that the students in Taiwan was very good at speech. Their speeches influenced me so much. Thanks to that, I was able to challenge whatever, like speech, group discussion, and questions.

However, I was not able to have good friendships with some people, because I was not able to have much in common to talk, and I could not understand what they said perfectly. So, I think that I should study English hard to understand what they say, and I should have knowledge of their backgrounds. Also, I had a quarrel with some people. That quarrel might be caused my poor skill in English. The skill perhaps leaded to misunderstandings between them and me. If I could say what I wanted to say really, I hadn't had the argue.

Also, I think that I owe what I am to what I was. I could do speech confidently, thanks to what I was.

In my childhood, I often read valedictory messages in front of many people. This experience enabled me to do speech openly. This program allows me to know the roots of my personality.

(4) The main problem in the future is to be ruled the roost in conversation. When I talked with the people in other countries, they ruled the roost in our talk. It seems thankful that the people who can speak English fluently grab what I want to say and they rule the roost in our talk, but if I were a business person, I could not become a good sales man, or an international player.
