Understand the importance of the research field or topic being explored by looking at the situation from the inside





# Improvement

The program helped to improve research skills – explore different angles of the issues, be creative



Study workshop on decision-making in case of the emergency



- ① Don't evacuate people, but alert them about the increase of volcano activity and level III Merapi Status.
  - Commander informs local volunteers and asks to pass the information to other members of community.
  - Operation section has to check on the local people if every one is safe.
- ② Inform people by hitting the gong / walky talky to volunteers & heads of the community.
  - \* for those who need to evacuate
  - \* for those who need to be alert
  - Start evacuation of the villages Umbulmartani and Sindumartani; those who locate close to 15 km radius and those who live close to the rivers
  - relocate <sup>vulnerable</sup> people from shelters in Umbulmartani to shelters in Bimomartani.
  - provide food and sanitation in shelters; medical support in 3 villages: Umbulmartani, Bimomartani, Sindumartani
  - talk to other regions to understand how many evacuee are there and in what condition; report to the planning section and collaborate with logistic

# Responsibility

The program connected students to professionals and practitioners in various fields.

It helped students to understand and realize that they will have to take on responsibility to take over current work, develop and create new ways and become a next generation of practitioners or academicians.
